Te Rito is a secure, cloud-based platform connecting SMSs with Ministry and other systems so information follows learners throughout their education.

2,834 learners changed schools two or more times ¹

1,504 were ākonga Māori

Te Rito supports a full understanding of learners' needs by making their attendance, achievement and participation information available in one place.

Connects schools, learners and their whānau* with learning information from SMSs, Ministry and other systems.

Enables an end-to-end digital record for every school-enrolled learner in New Zealand.

Informs teaching and learning, and helps school leaders make evidence-based decisions.

Supports collaboration between schools by providing a common view across clusters and national-reach schools.

Streamlines admin and reporting - reducing manual, double-handling of information.

Includes a range of other features and functions that schools can choose to use.
