Accessible by educators and students at any time, each record is a reliable, up-to-date profile that moves with them throughout their education.

Optimising learning experiences is easier when you're able to identify opportunities for growth or potential issues, and can tailor local practices and resources to support your students.

Te Rito starts with the student - and its dashboards are designed to help you easily track and report on outcomes.

Specific to your school, your view of consolidated, aggregated information from your SMS and a range of other education systems and sources is continuously enhanced as more schools connect to the platform, new data is added, and records are updated daily.

Use Te Rito's dashboards to:

- Inform roll growth management track enrolment numbers and patterns to anticipate shifts in capacity, staffing and resources.
- Align transition support monitor student arrivals and exits to ensure smooth onboarding and offboarding, especially at critical points – starting a new school, moving from primary to intermediate or intermediate to secondary, or leaving secondary.
- Provide transparency for leadership and boards

 of data enables aligned, evidence-based planning

Demographics dashboard

See basic enrolment data for your school and filter by enrolment type:

- Age
- Gender
- > Ethnicity
- Iwi
- Year level

Transitions dashboard

See enrolment reporting and filter by demographic data for your school, and:

- Prepare for transition peaks and ensure adequate support mechanisms are in place.
- Support planning with near-real-time data on roll growth shifts - identify and quantify incoming and exit trends to anticipate teaching, learning and community needs.
- Adjust class structures or timetables based on up-to-date enrolment numbers – or future numbers based on soon to be available preenrolment data.

Attendance dashboard

See attendance reporting and filter by demographic data for your school, and:

- Apply additional filtering by year, term, month, day or group.
- > Identify patterns, enable faster interventions, and track if they're making a difference.
- Connect progress, behaviour or wellbeing with attendance monitoring, and use insights to support conversations with parents and whānau.
- Apply analytics to timetabling/scheduling,
 resource planning and operational reporting
 in your school and with other schools.

Achievement dashboard

Te Rito's achievement dashboard provides principals with a further analytics solution in the toolkit. Compare attendance and achievement data and get the insights you need to understand and address any potential issues.

As with Te Rito's other dashboards, filter by demographic data for your school, and:

- Apply additional filtering by subject, year level, gender, ethnicity or individual students.
- Use patterns and trends to set meaningful, measurable targets and monitor strategies.
- Recognise early any issues impacting specific students or groups and identify curriculum areas needing targeted support or resourcing.
- Reference trusted data to show progress, guide conversations, qualify decisions and focus your support teams.

Informed leadership, effective governance

Te Rito's dashboards connect you, your leadership team and Board with insights – making it easier to ask the right questions, prepare data-informed responses, and focus on meaningful outcomes.
